




Lodging

A block of rooms has been reserved for the nights of July 16 and July 17. The rooms have a king or two double beds. The guest room rate per room, per night is \$60.

To receive the \$60 rate, you must identify the group as tiny-k Foundation and make the reservations by July 5, 2008. After that date, the hotel will release the remainder of the guest room block. Reservation requests after July 5th will be honored on a space and rate available basis.
